		Week 5, 10, & 15: Complete self-evaluation and review with AYE coordinator.
		There will be no guests during mid-terms and finals.
		Roommate requests will be considered contingent on their adherence to AYE guidelines.
		Guidelines are subject to change at the discretion of the Academic Housing Professional Staff.

Dining

Drumlin Hall Cafeteria and Conklin Atrium Snack & Convenience Store

- Dining Plans are still being negotiated with our vendor, Chartwells
- Our goal is to keep the meal plan costs within \$2,000-\$2,500 per semester
 - Declining Balances: \$2,000/semester = \$25/day, \$2,250/semester = \$29/day, \$2,500/semester = \$32/day
- There will be multiple meal plans to choose from based on your need
 - All residents are required to select a meal plan
 - Once available, you will be notified and can select your meal plan on your eRezLife account
- Dining services will be open at Drumlin Hall Cafeteria Monday-Friday
- Conklin Atrium Snack & Convenience Store will be open 7 days a week, hours will be posted in the Atrium once established

Housing Costs
