EOP Selection Criteria

Academic Criteria:

- Student must demonstrate the need for academic support as well as ability to complete college-level work.

Economic Criteria:

- Meet NYS Guidelines designated by the Board of Regents
- Requesting 2019 Tax Transcripts for parents & students

Interview:

- Have the opportunity to learn the story of our students and assess the resources we need to put in place

Participation in 3 week Summer Experience:

- July 26th through August 13th
- Modest allowance to be provided
- Emphasis on English, Math and College Success
